is planned for **September 12-18, 2021** in the *Mathematical Research and Conference Center (MRCC)* of the *Institute of Mathematics of the Polish Academy of Sciences* in Będlewo. The arrival day is Sunday, September 12 (the registration desk will be open from 4 p.m.). The departure is on Saturday, September 18, after lunch.

Będlewo is located in west-central Poland on the border of the *National Park of Wielkopolska* (26 km southwest from the center of Poznań). The MRCC is a place of many scientific conferences and workshops. You can get more information on the MRCC at the website
